A NO Vote Is Needed

The Board of Trustees analyzed the proposal to pledge \$20,000. a year for five years towards the Raising the Reader Program. This \$100,000.00 commitment was determined by a majority of the Board of Trustees (4/5) to be detrimental to the long-term financial health of our Lodge.

Entrusted with managing the assets of the Lodge, our previous Trustees always took the conservative approach. Their charitable contributions were reasonable and yet never exceeded more than \$1,000. a year. They made reasonable donations always keeping in mind the long-term welfare of the Lodge. Today, we are in a solid financial position because the Trustees were prudent with the Lodges' investments always making sure that sufficient funds were going to be there for future brethren.

*As stewards of this trust, the majority of the Trustees voted NO on this proposal.

*And it is our strong recommendation that the Lodge votes NO on this at the September Stated Meeting.
