These are the originators of our Annual Visitation with Live Oak Lodge No. 61. On the left is Bro. Jesse B. Near, PM and Treasurer of Alamo Lodge #122 and in the middle is Bro. George Porter, PM of Live Oak Lodge #61, F & A.M. On the right is John H. DeMartini. Live Oak Lodge visited Alamo Lodge in the fall of 1927 and Alamo Lodge visited Live Oak Lodge in the spring of 1928 and thus began these unbroken visitation.

A Tradition of Visitations AND A HISTORY OF FRIENDSHIP

""Traditions" have a way of starting in the most casual fashion, as can be attested by Jesse B. Near, Worshipful Master of Alamo Lodge in 1927. Through a mutual friend, Brother Near met George Porter, Worshipful Master of Live Oak Lodge No. 61 in Oakland. The friendship ripened and Live Oak Lodge was invited to visit Alamo Lodge in the fall of 1927. It was a large lodge, whereas Alamo was small and relatively poor, so Jesse Near supplied tomatoes from his farm for the refreshment table. The following spring Alamo Lodge visited Live Oak Lodge in Oakland. The exchange of visits was popular from the start and they have continued without a break. The tomatoes made a big hit and have continued to form the principal part of the menu on Live Oak Night. The Live Oak brethren have always brought their glee club, their orchestra, and a large group of members. Their visit has been one of the biggest events of each year."

The above is quoted verbatim from "The First One Hundred Years of Alamo Lodge No. 122, F. & A.M., Walnut Creek, California." The picture was secured by Bro. William E. Connelly, P.M. and Secretary, who had it framed and identified. He than gave it to our Worshipful Master, Bro. James A Leonard who in turn presented it to the Worshipful Master of Live


